#### FROM THE PASTOR —FR. MIKE TO LEAVE IN JUNE

On Sunday, January 14, I surprised the four parishes by announcing that I will be leaving in June. This was my choice as I realized that I no longer have the energy to bring together four parishes.

For five years I brought together two parishes in western Kenosha County. Then I spent 11 years in Dodge County finishing a merger of three parishes into one site while also bringing into that pastorate three more parishes. These 16 years of parish restructuring seems to have zapped all of that kind of energy out of me.

Many people have expressed sadness and frustration over my decision, which I understand. We have been getting specific projects moving forward – it is my intention to work with all of you over the next five months to keep building momentum on these projects to make the work of my successor lighter.

The future of Catholic Parishes in this state is this model of multi-parish pastorates. This model is happening in many other dioceses in the United States, Canada, and beyond. The Dodge County parishes I restructured are currently under further restructuring so there will be two pastorates for the whole county. Racine and its surrounding cities are doing the same – being brought together under two pastorates. The city of Waukesha went to one pastor for four parishes over five years ago. I could give many other examples. This isn't happening only to handle the reduced number of priests and reduced number of people coming to church, but it is a model to explore how to best use the internet, utilize specialized ministers, and have larger turnouts for unique evangelization opportunities. I hope you can even see this combined bulletin as an opportunity to explore your faith by following the Holy Spirit to an interesting event at a neighboring parish; you aren't betraying your parish but becoming a stronger Catholic to help your parish.

The Gospel reading for February 4 reports how Jesus healed many people then went off to pray and then went on to the neighboring village so as to preach to the whole of Galilee. We experience miracles locally but follow Jesus as he goes to the whole territory. May the Holy Spirit help us to follow and imitate Jesus.



We thank them for their partnership in Catholic Charities mission to provide service to those in need, to advocate for justice, and to call upon others to do the same.




